

KIRKSTEAD OLD MILL COTTAGE - reduced prices for 2016 - 2017

If you've stayed in Kirkstead Old Mill Cottage before, don't forget to mention it when rebooking, as the cost of your first night is reduced by £5.

Our nightly rates are for two people and include a full English breakfast each or our Gold Award healthy option.

The Balcony Bedroom is our largest en suite room where the beds can be arranged as twins or as a six-foot-wide double. It has a double, power shower/steam cubicle, WC and handbasin. The cost per night is £85, reducing to £75 for all subsequent nights.

The Monet Bedroom has a five-foot-wide bed and a spacious en suite bathroom with a whirlpool bath and a power shower over it, plus a WC and handbasin. It costs £75 for the first night, reducing to £65 for all subsequent nights.

The Bluebell twin room is just £65 because it does not have en suite facilities, but it is useful if you wish to bring additional members of the family with you. There is a private WC with handbasin just a few steps along the landing, and a bathroom downstairs with underfloor heating, a shower room, WC and hand basin. Additional nights are £55.

For just one person in any of the rooms, please deduct £20 off the above rates.

If breakfast is not required, please deduct £10 per person.

Arrive on foot, or on a pedal bicycle, and save an additional £10 per night.

Our optional 3 course evening meals plus tea or coffee, which must be ordered in advance, cost £22 per person. For guests with small appetites we can offer one or two courses. A single course costs *£14 and any two courses are available for £18.

*There is a £3 extra charge for Mrs Kind's home-grown roast lamb.
